In the original Greek, the word agape (sacrificial love) is used throughout Paul's first letter to the Corinthian church. This is translated into English as charity in the King James version; but the word love is preferred by most other translations.

We can do many things for the Lord if we work together in love. Spiritual gifts have their place for a time but love will endure forever. (1 Corinthians 12)
